AIMCO TEAM VOLUNTEERS OVER 5000 HOURS, RAISES OVER \$500,000 FOR NONPROFITS IN 2019

DENVER, CO., January 28, 2020 – Aimco business activities are defined by a commitment to our mission, vision, and the values which shape the Aimco culture. In 2019, the company and its team members celebrated 15 years of *Aimco Cares*, Aimco’s team-driven volunteer and philanthropic program.



The numbers are in, and we are excited to share that in 2019 just under 1,000 team members nationwide organized over 125 service activities and volunteered more than 5,000 hours to commemorate the anniversary.

Through *Aimco Cares*, all Aimco teammates receive 15 hours of paid time annually to volunteer in their local communities. Each hour volunteered is eligible for a \$15 financial match for the nonprofit organization of the team member’s choosing. This is in addition to other benefits provided through *Aimco Cares*,

including a scholarship fund for students of team members, an emergency fund to help teammates in crisis, and support for Aimco team members becoming United States citizens.

“Our goal with *Aimco Cares* is to care for both the Aimco family and the communities in which we live and work,” said Terry Considine, Aimco Chairman and CEO. “Our commitment to serve others is one reason Aimco has been recognized consistently as a top place to work.”

As a team-driven volunteer program, *Aimco Cares* provides the flexibility for teammates to support nonprofit organizations or initiatives that mean the most to them. Teammates have chosen to clean-up local parks, serve meals for various direct service organizations, fundraise and participate in local races and events, and stock items at local food banks.

In April and October, teammates came together around Spring and Fall Days of Service as another way to celebrate the anniversary. The designated 15 days of service saw team-building volunteer activities from San Jose, CA. to Boulder, CO. down to Miami, FL.



In addition to the time spent volunteering, Aimco supported military families and students in affordable housing by raising more than \$530,000 in proceeds from the 16th annual Charity Golf Classic. Beneficiaries include the Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (TAPS), Project Sanctuary, and the Aimco Cares Opportunity Scholarship administered by the National Leased Housing Association (NLHA).
